- Joseph R. Anderson, V.M.I., December, 1880-1882. <u>Assistants:</u> Charles M. Puckette, Sewanee; and Sylvanus Stokes, Virginia. <u>Publisher:</u> Theodore A. Johns, *Richmond*.

- 5. Walter T. Daniel, *Virginia*, 1889-1890. During 1890 the magazine bore the caption, *Palm: The Panhellenic Magazine*.
- 6. Otis A. Glazebrook, *V.M.I.*, 1891-1892. Lee C. Bradley, *Birmingham-Southern*; Louis C. Ehle, *Cornell*; and John M. Morris, *Sewanee*.
- 7. Louis C. Ehle, *Cornell*, 1893-1901. Milo H. Massey, *Mercer*; James H. Gannon, *St. Lawrence*; and Russel W. Taft, *Vermont*.
- 8. **N. Wiley Thomas**, *Pennsylvania*, February, 1902. Milo H. Massey, *Mercer*; James H. Gannon, *St. Lawrence*; and Russel W. Taft, *Vermont*. This issue was published by N. Wiley Thomas as Chairman of the High Council after Ehle's resignation and before the election of a successor.
